

# KANSAS STATE COUNCIL KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

Worthy Grand Knights, Team Captains, and Brother Knights:

This year's 68th Annual Knights of Columbus Men's Bowling Tournament will be held at Mission Bowl in Olathe 1020 S Weaver, Olathe, Kansas. The dates of the tournament are, Feb. 18-19, Feb. 25-26, and March 3-4.

An Invitation to participate should be extended to all Brother Knights in your Council. The tournament is open to League and Non-League Bowlers. Current Membership card will be required when checking in.

LEAGUE BOWLERS: It is very important that league bowlers obtain the signature from their league secretary verifying averages and sanction numbers. The TEAM CAPTAIN will be responsible for filling out the entry form, including sanction numbers, averages, and attaching the league secretary form. If a non league bowler is on your team, leave his average blank. Also indicate the first and second choice for dates and times to bowl. Bring a substitute if a bowler that signed up cannot attend. (This will reduce the number of phone calls in regard to scheduling).

NON-LEAGUE BOWLERS: those who have bowled in any of the previous men's tournament will use the average supplied by the State Bowling Committee from the tournament record. First time non-league bowlers will enter with a 135 or higher average.

## 2013 TOURNAMENT SITE

Councils interested in hosting the 2013 tournament must make their request in writing, along with a letter from the bowling establishment (quote on price of lineage) to the State Bowling Chairman by January 20, 2012. Remit to Stephen Abels

REQUIREMENTS- at least 24 lanes, three consecutive weekends starting the third weekend in February, and sufficient housing accommodations which meet the approval of the State Bowling Committee. Bowlers will chose, by popular vote, the next year's tournament location.

# Knights of Columbus 68<sup>th</sup> State Bowling Tournament Rules

Bowlers must be members of the Knights of Columbus and produce a current paid up Membership Card.

**Team Events.** Multiple participation will be allowed in team events only according to Rule 317(a) in the ABC Constitution Specifications and Rules. No more than three bowlers on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. A bowler bowling on more than one team will count his first Team event score for his all events.

**Singles and Doubles.** No entered, or substitute, bowler will be permitted to bowl singles unless he bowls doubles. No bowler will be permitted to bowl doubles unless he bowls singles. Singles and Doubles will be bowled three (3) bowlers to each lane, and singles will be bowled first. The automatic telescore is the official score. Each bowler is responsible for observing his own score at all times. A bowler has 24 hours in which to register an official written protest to any scoring error.

Class 1 - Team Average	790 and Above
Class 1 - Doubles Average	316 and Above
Class 1 - Singles Average	158 and Above
Class 2 - Team Average	789 and Below
Class 2 - Doubles Average	315 and Below
Class 2 - Singles Average	157 and Below
Class 3 - Singles	135 Entry

**All Events.** Optional All Events scores will include singles and double scores, and the score for the first team event of each bowler.

**Entering Averages.** Bowlers must use their highest 2010-2011 local ABC Bowling Association book average of 2010-2011 league average. When the previous season's average is used, and at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 pins or more higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used.

**Average Verification.** League Secretary, or local ABC Bowling Association Secretary, must verify on this entry blank the highest 2010-2011 average over 21 games for bowlers having no 2010-2011 local ABC Bowling Association book average.

**All Non-League Bowlers** simply leave the average column blank, as the Bowling Committee will supply the cumulative average from Past K of C Tournaments. If none of the above, 135 or higher entering average will be used.

**All Bowlers** will be subject to re-rating if the bowler's average in each of the bowler's last two K of C Tournaments is 15 pins or more above his entering average. Re-rating will be 100% of the 15 game average. Rule 319(e) is waived.

**Average Corrections.** Average corrections can be made up to the end of the game in any series. ABC Rule 319(e) is waived. If the submitted average is higher than that required under these rules, prize-winnings will be based on the submitted average.

If the submitted average is lower than that required under these rules and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowlers score is disqualified.

**Misrepresenting an average on any entry shall be grounds for disqualification of the entry (team, doubles, or singles) and forfeiture of any/all prize money which might have resulted for that entry.**

**Entry Fee Details.** Entry Fees in full must accompany the entry blank and shall be tendered by Check or Money Order. No entry fee shall be refunded, except in the case of rejection of an entry. Previous tournament earnings need not be declared.

**Handicaps.** Handicap will be 85% of 225. All bowlers make sure your applicable average is correct as stated on this entry form.

**Substitutions.** Any substitutions must be made ONE HOUR before the scheduled time to bowl in the same lineup position as the bowler he replaces.

**Captain's Responsibilities.** Each Team Captain shall fill in the names of the bowlers in the order in which they will bowl and include **their proper average.** It is the Captain's responsibility to register his team at the Tournament Desk and least 1 HOUR prior to bowling. Team lineups may not be changed after submitting original entry. A substitute will take the place of the original bowlers position. Team Captains must insure that each bowler has his current paid up K of C traveling card. It will be the sole responsibility of the Team Captain to encourage his team members to conduct themselves as Catholic gentlemen during the Knights of Columbus Bowling Tournament.

**ABC Cards.** Non Sanctioned bowlers may pay affiliate membership dues of the local association to qualify for ABC score awards.

**Mechanical Failure.** In the event of mechanical failure or any other unscheduled delay of play, it is hereby agreed that the contestants affected shall be moved to the first available pair of lanes.
